Vice Mayor stated some citizens are concerned with the post office traffic.

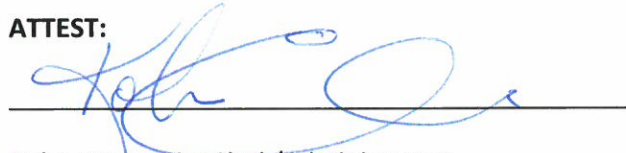
Mayor stated he was thankful for the information at the debate.
