The Mayor went on to state that he was against this offer because it includes giving away a piece of Jimmie Vann's Sunrise Park and he feels that is not Jimmie Vann's intent for the park. He also stated he is not in favor giving 5 foot of the pier property away to the neighboring property to the north, as the City is need of ADA parking there.

Commissioner Bittle and Commissioner Lindlau agreed.

The Mayor stated that Mr. Dewees claims his property to the south of the pier property extends 380 feet out into the river. The Mayor asked Mr. Dewees what document does he have to support that?

Mr. Dewees stated he believes his lawyer is the one that has that information.

The City Attorney stated the City should get a surveyor to interpret the legal description.

Commissioner Bracy stated he feels the City should move the pier and sell the property.

Commissioner Lindlau made a motion and it was seconded by Commissioner Bittle to reject the offer from Soladad, Inc. The motion passed unanimously.

The City Administrator requested the permission to purchase a Kawasaki Mule with a dump trailer for \$1200 from Vice Mayor Hyatt's husband. The Commission agreed to the purchase, with Vice Mayor Hyatt giving no opinion.
