### MINUTES

#### A. Opening

After refreshments provided by WF Chair Donia Dewees, the Waterfront Committee members in attendance, Donia Dewees and Jane Andrews, welcomed guest presenter Melinda Donnelly and her husband.

B. Melinda Donnelly, PhD candidate at UCF, who works with Dr. Linda Walters at the Seminole Rest Living Shoreline project, discussed the idea of partnering with the City to apply for Indian River Lagoon National Estuary Program funds in order to help the City combat the erosion problem at Sunrise Park. The deadline is January 15, 2014. In-kind volunteer work is counted toward the requirement of matching funds. Attendees felt that Burns Sci-Tech Charter School students would be one good source of enthusiastic participants, placing oyster bags and mangrove plantings. Ms. Donnelly would draw up the proposal in time for the January 13 Commission meeting for consideration.
