## **MINUTES**

A. Call to Order & Roll Call

The meeting was called to order at 6:05. Present were Donia Dewees, Cynthia Livingston, and Paul Davis. Absent was Joseph Ludwig.

B. Approval of the 2/11/2014 Meeting Minutes

Vice Chair Cynthia Livingston made a motion, seconded by Member Paul Davis, to approve the Feb. 11 meeting minutes. The motion passed with a roll call vote of 3-0.

  - 1. Vice Chair Cynthia Livingston led a discussion about participating in the annual Riverfest at Mary Dewees Park, Saturday, May 10, by setting up a booth with information about lagoon matters and the Waterfront Committee activities.
  - 2. Waterfront Chair Donia Dewees reported that she had called Mary Paulic of Florida's Dept. of Environmental Protection. Ms. Paulic suggested that for the City to get an out-of-cycle water quality assessment in order to qualify for TMDL monitoring of our area of the Mosquito Lagoon, the request should come from the City Commission. Donia will write up a draft of such a letter and speak to the Mayor about bringing it before the Commission. We need to follow up for a written explanation of the Nutrient Management Plan that was offered in DEP's Dec. 20, 2013 letter signed by Beth Alvi.
  - 3. Fishing Line Recycling Program: No report this time.

Vice Chair Cynthia Livingston expressed continued concern about the Coastal Restoration dredging. She likes the informational YouTube video that Buck Carr has produced showing the problems. Members discussed ways to make an even more effective documentary on YouTube to spread the word.
