1. Acceptance of minutes from 2/18/16: Debbie accepted, Denise seconded.
2. We received an anonymous donation of \$1500. We will also be receiving donations in memory of Mike McCallum. We made \$220 at the Pet Life bake sale in January.
3. Our town balance is \$4025.59. Michelle will be asking for \$2400 at the town council meeting in May. We made \$220 from the Pet Life Bake Sale in January.
4. It has been brought to our attention that we can advertise our upcoming events in the Cider Hill newsletter.
5. Zuma has been adopted. He was sheltered at AWS for three nights. Nicole has told us that she is interested in fostering dogs.
6. The following meetings will be held at the Town Hall: May, June, July, August, and September.
7. Bev has been getting many donations for the Rummage Sale. Ninety percent of it are women's clothes. We will need to be there at 7 AM to set up and organize the clothing. We will also have raffle items and a bake sale. There will be a \$5 per bag charge for clothes. We have use of the Grange at no charge. It is a community event between us and the Grange.
8. Bev and Debbie attended a meeting of the County Animal Rescue Team. The meetings are held in Alfred. Being a part of the team requires a criminal background check and being up to date on your tetanus shot. You also will take emergency management classes. You could travel out of state to rescue animals. Debbie has applications if anyone is interested.
9. The Chowder Fest is May 14. We will discuss it more at next month's meeting.
10. A Paint Night fundraiser was discussed. There is a new place in Saco and we would only need 10 people to participate. They would donate \$10 per ticket. August or September would be a good time to do it.

11. The owner of Bull Dog Cafe said we can have a dog adoption in his parking lot, possibly in June. We would also have a bottle drive.

12. We have found out that coyote urine will not work to repel fisher cats. There are also some raccoons that need to be trapped. Michelle has called Bruce Martin. She and Daniel will be going to a class in August to get a license to trap.
