Minutes of the North Cove Historic District Commission,  
meeting held on January 24, 1987 at the Old  
Saybrook Town Hall at 4:00 P.M.

Suzie Cole called the meeting to order at 4:05 P.M.  
Suzie appointed alternates Mona Johnson and  
Charles Fisher to represent regulars Shelly  
Shepley and Dick Tietgen respectively.

The meeting was attended by Police Chief  
Ed Moska who explained that the Police  
Dept had received a letter from the  
Waterfront Commission requesting that  
signs be erected at the landing site and  
launch site on North Cove Road. According  
to our regulations, a Certificate of Appropriateness  
is required for this, and it was determined  
that a letter to the Police Department  
considering sign removal would be in order.

Second by Mona Johnson passed  
unanimously.

Suzie Cole read a letter by Betty Shurts regarding  
the Dubec home and the garage doors. She  
objected to the round garage door openings.  
It was determined that the openings were  
different than the original plan that  
was approved. After much discussion,  
Bill Swayne moved to reject the new  
garage door plan. Second was by Charles  
Tiedler, passed, unanimously.

It was also noted that the front  
door is not exactly as shown on the plan.  
Mona Johnson moved that the Dubec's ask  
for a certificate of appropriateness variance  
for the front door change. Suzie Cole  
second, passed unanimously. Suzie  
will contact the Dubec's as soon as  
possible.

Mona Johnson moved to adjourn at  
4:55 pm. Second, Charles + Tiedler, passed.
