

NORTH COVE HISTORIC DISTRICT COMMISSION

Minutes of the special Meeting of May 9, 1990, 8:PM  
Present, S.Wardlaw, Chair, J.Schneider, W. Swayne, R.  
Tietjen and Lynne Wardlaw

The minutes of the April 4th meeting were read and approved  
with this addition on page 1 "Further business..." line 3:

"that no public hearing is required since not sufficiently  
significant."

The Chair reviewed the chronology of correspondence and  
efforts to make contact with Mr. and Mrs. Richard Kelly, 91  
North Cove Road re the appropriateness of the lamps in front  
of their house. Especially in question are the posts, made  
of cast iron, a material not available at the time the house  
was built. The lamps are of uncertain style or vintage. It  
is noted that they were installed, after Mr. and Mrs. Kelly  
were in residence, without a certificate of appropriateness.

The Chair read the letter written by him on April 5th at the  
behest of the Commission, reported the receipt of the  
message by Mr. Kelly and returning Mr. Kelly's call. Mr.  
Kelly's secretary reported that he wanted to know what the  
Chair's letter meant. There has been no other response to  
date.

The Chair then read Town Attorney Donovan's letter to Mr.  
Kelly and reported that he had tried various times to reach  
Mr. Kelly by phone during the last week in April, to no  
avail.

It was moved (Schneider) and seconded (L. Wardlaw) to the  
direct the Chair to write to the Board of Selectmen  
requesting that appropriate action be taken by the Town  
Attorney, unanimously approved.

Adjournment was moved (Schneider) and seconded (L. Wardlaw)  
to adjourn  
at 8:57. Passed without dissent.
