2018 Boating Season

**REQUEST FOR MOORING PERMIT FOR 2018 IN THE WATERS OF OLD SAYBROOK,
CONNECTICUT, OTHER THAN NORTH COVE'S DREDGED AREA.**

Attached is a mooring permit for the 2018 season. It must be completed by anyone who wishes a mooring in Old Saybrook. An outhaul is also required to have a permit as it is considered a mooring by the State of Connecticut. The forms must be filled out completely. All mooring holders must indicate where they keep their dinghy. **Every mooring is to be inspected annually prior to it being placed** in the water. **If it is currently in the water it must be pulled for inspection.**

The mooring permit fee for the following areas, clothesline area, Knollwood, Indiantown, Oyster River, Ferry Point Anchorage and for waterfront property owners, directly in front of their homes:

\$ 79.76 (\$ 75.00 & 4.76 tax).

The mooring permit fee for the flats and the river area outside of North Cove
\$ 159.52 (\$ 150 & 9.52 tax).

Any communication regarding mooring permits, even if you speak to Scott Mitchell, Harbor Master **must** be followed up in writing to the Harbor Management Commission

Please note the Commission is requesting a copy of your CT registration.

In addition to completing the form and submitting requested items, *requesting your permit early* is the best way for the inspection and paperwork to be completed promptly. You must allow approximately 3 weeks for the process.

Note: Mooring should have adequate ground tackle, pendant (s), chafing gear and scope for the area and conditions expected. A vessel riding on its mooring must not infringe on other moorings. Moorings, by action of the wind or current, shall not encroach upon navigation channels maintained by the Corp of Engineers, or interfere with established fairways, wharves, docks or floats. Mooring buoys shall be white. The weight of the anchor with the # sign and the boat owners LAST name shall be PAINTED on the buoy.
