OLD SAYBROOK POLICE COMMISSION Special Meeting February 8, 2016 MINUTES

A special meeting of the Old Saybrook Police Commission was held on Monday, February 8, 2016 at the Old Saybrook Town Hall.

Present: Chairman Stuart, Vice Chairman Von Dassel, Secretary Moran and Commissioner Burhman were present and Commissioner Cooper phoned in via conference call. Chief Spera was present from the Department of Police Services.

I. Call to Order / Pledge of Allegiance

Chairman Stuart called the meeting to order at 7:01PM and led those in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance.

II. Discussion and Possible Action concerning the Communication from the First Selectman on the appointment of two Police Commissioners to serve on the Board of Selectman's Ad Hoc Committee to study and make recommendations concerning the replacement of the Police Boat.

Secretary Moran made a motion for Commissioner Maselli and Cooper to serve on the First Selectman's Ad Hoc Committee. Vice Chairman Von Dassel seconded the motion. The motion for Commissioner Maselli and Cooper to serve on the First Selectman's Ad Hoc Committee for Marine Patrol passed with a vote of 5 in favor and 0 against.

Secretary Moran made the motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Vice Chairman Von Dassel. The motion to adjourn the meeting passed with a vote of 5 in favor and 0 against.
