MINUTES

Present: First Selectman Carl P. Fortuna Jr., Selectman Scott Giegerich, Selectman Steve Gernhardt, Lt. Kevin Roche, Fire Chief J.T. Dunn, Fire Marshal Donn Dobson, Tax Collector Barry Maynard, Library Director Michele Van Epps, and Finance Director Lisa Carver.

I. CALL TO ORDER – First Selectman Fortuna called the meeting to order at 3:30 P.M.

II. BUSINESS BEFORE THE BOARD

A. Discuss and act on FY 2014-15 budget recommendation to the Board of Finance.

Selectman Gernhardt asked what the impact on the changes in the Grand List from revaluation had on the budget as he was concerned about shortfalls. First Selectmen Fortuna responded that the Grand List is a factor in the calculation of the mill rate along with any increases in expenditures. A discussion followed on the revenue side of the budget, including state revenues and local fees. The First Selectmen recently attended a Council on Small Towns (COST) meeting where legislators and state government officials indicated there would not be any big changes to funds for municipalities.

Selectmen Gernhardt asked if the upcoming projects such Kohls/Big Y would shift the split between commercial and residential real estate. First Selectman Fortuna indicated it would not shift much – the split is currently approximately 90% residential; 10% commercial.
