Septic, Severage and Pollution Concerns

The community septic system needed for this size development would handle the equivalent capacity of one of the largest community septic systems ever constructed or permitted in the state. Per state law, the town and its taxpayers would be

responsible for the cost of maintenance and the cost of repair should this system fail. The development of this property also threatens to pollute drinking water wells, streams and the nearby Oyster River with fertilizers and pesticides


