At the regular meeting of the Old Saybrook Planning Commission on Wednesday, 3/16/2011, the following decision was rendered:

Application for a Modification to Approved Special Exception for Preliminary Open Space Subdivision Plan for 226 total dwelling units (925.82 total ac.) & Open Space (556.83 total ac.) filed by River Sound Development, LLC, for property located at Assessor's Map 55, Lot 3 and Map 56, Lot 6 and Map 61, Lots 15, 17, & 18, Ingham Hill Road and Bokum Road, Old Saybrook and west of Route 153 in Westbrook. Preliminary open space subdivision plan with the Residence C, Conservation District, approved in 2005 for which modifications were sought including, but not limited to: rearranging the distribution of units around the perimeter of the parcel; allocating 9 units to the Planta Parcel (west of Bokum Road); allowing such perimeter development to be on private septic systems instead of public sewers; allowing the Planta Parcel and units off of Ingham Hill Road to be on private wells instead of public water; and designating a location for active recreation fields. Decision: APPROVED with conditions and restrictions, on a vote of 3-2. Restrictions and conditions of the approval included, but were not limited to: conceptual approval of a "T" intersection near the end of Ingham Hill Road; additional review of the active recreation field designs, trailhead parking, and nature pavilion at the time of subdivision submission; additional studies requested by Town public safety agencies; retention of road widths and lengths as approved in 2005; additional measures for Box Turtle and Prickly Pear protection; adjustments to drainage designs; driveway relocation for Lots #3 and #4 on the Planta Parcel, and for the recreation area near the end of Ingham Hill Road; and such other items as contained in the Motion for Approval.
