## Architectural Review Committee January 27, 2011

Meeting called to order at 6:30 p.m.

Formerly Army/Navy, 101 Rte. 6A, represented by Steve Tarquini (cont'd from 1/13/11). Proposes new siding – lower façade, clapboard, color: woodland cream JH10-30, James Hardie siding products. Pat made a motion to approve as submitted. Will seconded and the vote was 5-0-0.

<u>Cape Cod Regional Transit Authority</u>, 10 Rte. 6A, represented by Matt Kolva (cont'd) from 1/13/11). Proposes same location as previously stated. New changes - asbestos roofing, install bollards, one door, glass in back, sign: white background/blue lettering, RTA logo blue/green. Will made a motion to approve as revised subject to set-backs and safety issues to be determined by Brian Harrison, Building Commissioner. Pat seconded and the vote was 4-1-0 (John Kelsey voted against).

The Red Balloon Toy Shop, 114 Rte. 6A, represented by Paul Jeffrey, owner and Bill VonThaden (builder). Proposes to replace front steps using existing brick structure for the base for new mahogany steps, new handrails – fir to be left natural, 24' – 0" wide – decking runs parallel with building. Carolyn made a motion to approve as submitted. Chuck seconded and the vote was 5-0-0. John recused himself due to long standing business relationship with Mr. VonThaden.

<u>Weekend</u>, 217 Main St., represented by Andrew Wade. Proposes two solar panels on roof - south side of building- flushed mounted - twelve panels on dormer roof, four panels on neighboring roof. Carolyn made a motion to approve as submitted. John seconded and the vote was 5-0-0.

Main Street Wine & Gourmet, 42 Main St., represented by Sandy Blajda. Proposes new awning over door 8" x 13'6" (to be centered over door), umbrella fabric – color - basil, Captain's Navy color for the binding, logo on awning – blue lettering. John asked if any other signs were being proposed. If at a future date they would like additional signs the owner would need ARC approval. John made a motion to approve as submitted. Pat seconded and the vote was 5-0-0.



<u>Cape & Islands Tire</u>, 135 Rte. 6A, represented by Gilbert Wood. Proposes new roof, architectural design shingles, gray blue color, thirty-five year shingle. John asked if current sign with the lights would remain and informed applicant regarding new lighting bylaw. The matter was deferred to the Building Commissioner. **Will made a motion to approve as submitted. Carolyn seconded and the vote was 5-0-0.**
