- 1. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER BY CHAIRMAN JON HOLT AT 1PM
- 2. MINUTES: The minutes of the last meeting on February 2nd were approved 4-0-0.
- 3. BOB JONES PROPOSAL

Bob Jones outlined his background as a social worker specializing in retardation and autism. He is interested in establishing a campus style residential community for adults with autism.

This creative plan, entitled CAPE COD VILLAGE, INC, would consist of 4 homes and one social center housing 12 adults who would live under supervision.

He is presently looking for adequate land to build this complex and would like it to be within walking distance to a the town.

This is a 6 year project and 2012 is the first year of the plan.

We asked that he keep us informed of his progress.
