Bike Events in Orleans

Sharrows

This did not make it on the agenda for the board of selectmen because it has been too full. This really needs to be at the top of our list, as it will improve safety for bikers and drivers and help to keep the J1 students on the rights side of the road. Hank did the research and Mark Budnick from the Highway department already has the sharrow stencil, and just needs the board of selectmen to give approval and designate the routes. We are going to make a brief public comment about it at the July 10th Board of Selectmen's meeting and Katy will meet with Hank to make sure we have all the necessary information ahead of time. Margy attended a Cape Wide bike event and noted that Orleans was the only town present that doesn't have designated bike routes around town.

Discussion of Bike Traffic Improvement-

Discussion tabled, ^{YD.} Carl will invite Tom Daley of Highway Department to our next meeting to discuss the concern of Safety on West Rd.

Bike Safety for J1 Students

Determined that we cannot ask Stop and Shop or Shaws to donate actual money towards buying the blinking lights for J1 Students, but we can ask them to buy the lights directly and the Bike and Pedestrian Committee can distribute. – Katy will approach the stores and get the lights ordered to be passed out at the J1 Student Summer Kickoff event at Rock Harbor on June 26th. Orleans Cycle can get the lights for \$6 a piece and is volunteering to go to the event to put the lights directly on the bikes.

Recommendation of Class 3 Bike Routes in Orleans

1. Nauset Beach
2. Rock Harbor
3. Skaket Beach

All routes have direct access to the Cape Cod Rail Trail (CCRT)

The Orleans Bike & Pedestrian Committee recommends these 3 routes (as defined by the map below) should be designated Class 3 Bike Routes.
