1. The meeting was called to order at 5:00 pm in the Nauset Room at Town Hall. In attendance; Steve Bornemeier, Julia Enroth (chair), Sue Christie, James Hadley, Catherine Hertz (clerk), Jon Holt, Alan McClennen (vice-chair), Steve Phillips.

2. Public Hearing - CPA Project Recommendations for May 2012 Annual Town Meeting. Julia

read the public hearing notice that was published in the Cape Codder.

- a. Orleans Affordable Housing Trust Fund applicant: Affordable Housing Committee. Amount requested \$70,000. Preliminary recommendation \$40,000.
- b. Namskaket Rd. Community Housing/Open Space/Historic Preservation applicant Habitat for Humanity of Cape Cod, Inc. Amount requested \$615,000. Preliminary recommendation \$615,000.
- c. Archival Preservation III Glass Plates and Lantern Slides applicant: Orleans **Historical Society**

Amount requested \$7,000. Preliminary recommendation: \$7,000.

- d. Heating and Air Conditioning System applicant: Federated Church of Orleans Amount requested \$121,000. Preliminary recommendation \$0.
- e. Odd Fellows hall Restoration (Phase V) applicant: Independent Order of Odd Fellows Lodge #132.

Amount requested \$96,762. Preliminary recommendation to be determined.

- Paul Davies and David Maclean (architect) both made presentations on the best ways to use the building. David said it would be take about \$900,000 to complete the project without the third floor.
- Catherine Hertz suggested they apply for non-profit status and the National Historic Register.
- Bill Wardell, Noble Grand of Odd Fellows explained what the Odd Fellows paid for (electricity, septic system, insulation, etc.) and the volunteer hours. He said other lodges have donated funds. Preliminary recommendation: To be determined
- f. Fleck Property on Twinings Pond (Acquisition II) applicant: Orleans Conservation

Amount requested \$120,000. Preliminary recommendation: \$60,000 minimum.

- g. Nauset Beach Access Plan applicant: Orleans Planning Department. Amount requested \$4,500. Preliminary recommendation \$0.
- h. Committee Expenses: Maximum allowable \$40,250. Preliminary recommendation \$10,000
- i. Historic Resources Reserves: Preliminary recommendation: To be determined. On a motion made by Alan McClennen and seconded by Steve Bornemeier it was moved to close the public hearing. 8-0-0
