Discussion regarding 2009 grant winner reimbursements. Paperwork has been completed and filed with the town administration to reimburse Cape Cod Museum of Art (internship program), John Root, (Senior Center Cabaret), and Jay Mankita (Eat Like a Rainbow.)

October 3-5. The OCC decided that it would not be participating this year, but would like to meet with the

Arts Foundation to learn more about the organization and discuss Orleans participation in the future.
