ORLEANS CULTURAL COUNCIL

Attending: Joanna Keeley, Anne Williams, Meri Hartford, Elizabeth Kuechenmeister and Board of Selectman Liaison Susan B. Christie

Upon a motion by Joanna Keeley and seconded by Anne Williams, meeting was called to order at 1:07pm. The vote was 4-0.

Board of Selectman Liaison Susan B. Christie was introduced to the council.

Upon a motion by Joanna Keeley, and seconded by Anne Williams, the minutes of April 23 were approved. The vote was 4-0.

The Orleans Cultural Council approved paperwork to reimburse 2010 grant winners Cape Cod Lighthouse Charter School and Cape Cod Museum of Art.

Anne Williams, co-chair of the Council was elected to another three year term, upon a motion by Meri Hartford and a second by Elizabeth Kuechenmeister. The vote was 3-0-1. (Ms. Williams abstained.)

The council discussed upcoming projects for 2010. The Community Input Forum will take place this summer, and the council is planning to place questionnaires at public venues -- Orleans Town Hall, Snow Library, Chamber of Commerce. The questionnaires will help the council understand the cultural needs and interests of residents.

The need for increased artwork in Orleans Town Hall was discussed. The council agreed that more artwork in town hall will create community and encourage local artists. The council discussed the vetting process for submitted artwork.

The council discussed the venue for the Margaret Fernald Dole Juried Art show, which will take place in the fall of 2010. Possible venues include the Snow Library and the Odd Fellows Hall.

The council reviewed its webpage on the Massachusetts Cultural Council website.

The council reviewed the new Open Meeting Law.
