III PRIORITY BUSINESS:

- A. <u>Administrators' Reports</u>: Principal Diane Carreiro reviewed her Principal's report, a copy of which was included in the packet. Diane discussed student achievement, monthly enrollment, professional development, community outreach, capital improvement building maintenance, and the opportunity the students had to view the inauguration on various televisions at the school.
- B. <u>Consider FY 2010 Budget</u>: Prior to Diane Carreiro discussing the budget, Supt. Gradone discussed state aid and reported that the Orleans Elementary School FY 10 budget has an increase of 2.52% excluding fringe benefits.

Principal Diane Carreiro reviewed line by line the FY 10 Orleans Elementary School Budget of \$3,055,242, a 2.52% increase. Discussion followed. Diane mentioned the possibility of putting Orleans Elementary School capital projects through the Town, versus the Orleans Elementary School operating budget. Diane said she would discuss further after obtaining more information from the Town.

The school committee will revisit the budget at their February meeting after reviewing and discussing it with the Town of Orleans Selectmen and Finance Committee members.
