
<u>Minutes</u> <u>Orleans 4th of July Committee</u> Thursday, April 14, 2011

The meeting was called to order at 5:00pm
The minutes of the December 9, 2010 meeting were unanimously approved.

1. Update from *The Friends Of The Fourth*Bruce Ayer gave a rundown of the expenses for 2010. \$18,594 was spent for 2010. They have \$17000 in bank to start with for this year. They are going to do their mailing by May 15.
They have some new Committee members in addition to Kathy Mead, Ken Farrar and Bruce. John Gasperine and Murry Barnard have joined the Friends. Bruce noted that all bulk mailing has to be made from main PO, not East Orleans anymore. The Friends will also have a table at Nauset Marine's 50th anniversary celebration on July 23rd.

At this time, Ingrid reported that she had heard from Dawson Farber also. It was decided that the Town Committee will have a table at the celebration too. Ingrid will let Dawson Farber know that we want our table next to the Friends table. Bonnie will chat with Margie about possibility of our collecting during this time.

2. Budget

- The 4th of July Warrant Article is written "up to 8,000.00", so even though that is above the % that the Town has requested increases be kept below, Margie has said that it is fine to leave the language as is. She will speak to it as she presents our warrant article at Town Meeting.
- The Fireworks and Band Contracts are all set
- Signs and Banner We need make new covers for days of week and numbers, covers that are removable so that dates can be changed more easily from year to year. Dave has found some material at True Value that he thinks will work. He will also call the Tech about the possibility of them doing it.
- Trophies The Committee decided that they are comfortable staying with the trophies that we had last year.
- The idea of Lifetime Award for *The Farm* was brought up, being that they either win, or place each year. We could not come to a consensus so will continue the discussion at a later date.
