The minutes of the May 12, 2011 meeting were unanimously approved

Old Business:

- 1. Update from The Friends Of The Fourth
 - After doing their Mailing, the Friends has a balance of \$7800 in the bank. They additionally spent \$260.00, paying for one half of a new 4th of July banner. Bruce said that funds coming in from their mailing are down and he wondered if an article in the newspaper might help. A question was raised as to why The Friends couldn't email their solicitation letter to everyone to save money and it was determined that they don't have that capability.
 - We discussed having something on Channel 18.... About "Friends of the 4th is Happy to be sponsoring the Fireworks again this year." Bonnie will check with Sarah Eaton at Town Hall about this.
 - Bonnie will also look into how the Friends can have a link on the Town Website's Community Page.
 - Bruce reported that he had spoken with Shawn Delude from, Nauset Disposal, and that they
 will donate both the trash containers and the porta-potties. We will put in to ask to get his
 tipping fee waived at the Transfer Station.
 - Kathy said that Jim Junkins, from Friends Market, again wants 4th collection containers in his store as of June 1st. She will get them to him.
 - Bruce spoke about a liability write-off from each non-profit group that Nauset Marine wants for their 50th event. The Friends doesn't have an insurance policy. Ingrid will talk with Dawson Farber about what other non-profits are doing.
 - Bruce had received a note that there were too many vehicles and not enough marchers in the Parade.
 - The possibility of having float for those with a 4th of July birthday was mentioned. We can add a line about it in the article for the newspaper.

2. Budget

- Banner update
 - -It was decided that we would purchase a new banner from Young and Fancy for \$520.00. The Friends of the Fourth will pay for half of the cost, \$260.00. Dave Hubbard brought a check for that amount over to Young and Fancy. They said that they will have the banner ready by June 15th. from Friends ready on June 15th
- Bonnie will contact Margie about any decisions from the Selectboard regarding permits and dates for the banner
