Parade

 - -We discussed the need for another set of signs designating where the Bands and Dignitaries stage

Decorating

- -Un-decorating is still a problem.
- -It was suggested that the Paul Nossitor and Steel Drum Band should make their own signs. They would need to be notified.
- -Two new bands, Warren and the African Drum, were invited to participate and will be paid to be in the Parade next year.
- Band Staging Area OES
 - -We need a couple of trash bags at elementary school. Susan will put them there.
- Float Staging Area NRMS
 - We would like to NOT have any kids get dropped off at the staging area but have a drop-off point where they can meet/gather with their group (the bank, library, etc) and then head over to the staging.
