### 2. Preservation Easements

The town meeting warrant moves the responsibility from the CPC to the Orleans Conservation Commission. The CPC hired a person with expertise, Eric Drey of Provincetown, to assist them in reviewing projects. The CPC has a budget, which the OHC does not. Buildings which have received money from the CPC in the past, have preservation easements on them and when they want to make additional changes, interior or exterior, the project will have to be reviewed by the OHC. The Commission can say yes or no. We need to get a list of all buildings with preservation easements on them. The CPC now knows that they need an historic structure report before funding work on any historic building.

#### New makeup of OHC

The town has an application from Bryant Besse to be on the Commission. He has met with the Selectmen but has not been appointed yet. He was born in Orleans and his family has owned many old buildings. He has 30 years experience as a carpenter working on mostly old historic buildings and mostly in Chatham.
