CALL TO ORDER

Chair O'Reilly called the meeting to order at 5:18 p.m.

PRIORITY BUSINESS

Superintendent's Evaluation

Chair O'Reilly asked the Committee to review and vote on the Superintendent Evaluation which includes Dr. Hoffmann's self-assessment, goals, and action plan for 2012-13. He noted that Union 54 previously voted to approve the document but the Region Committee could not due to lack of a quorum. He requested the Region School Committee members vote the document so that it can be sent to the state.

Dr. Hoffmann indicated that some of the Joint School Committee members wanted a more measureable document but most understood the document would be revisited each year. Dr. Hoffmann indicated he was concentrating on the communication piece and will attend school council and PTA/PTO/PTC meetings. It was asked if the evaluation could be completed before May and Dr. Hoffmann indicated he would look at this to determine if there will be enough time to do so.

The evaluation will be submitted to the state for review by Claudia Bach. The state can critique it, but their main focus is to make sure it meets the regulations.

Discussion ensued relative to the document being a "changing document" and that there will be opportunities to revisit it in the future. Chair O'Reilly indicated this would be on the agenda at the summer meetings for review. Chair O'Reilly indicated there would be a mid-cycle review in late January.

Motion:

On a motion by Sarah Blackwell, seconded by Jon Porteus, it was voted unanimously to approve the Superintendent's evaluation as printed.
