- 6. Mark Robinson briefed the Committee about the ongoing collaboration with the Town of Brewster in the Clay Pond Road area in Brewster. They are presently working to purchase the 3 acre Jackson property which lies in the Zone II of the Orleans watershed.
- 7. The Chairman reported that the Management plan for the Putnam property has been approved by the State and other activities are planned for the Fall to prepare the property for the planned uses.
