

**Town of Oxford
Thompson Lake Advisory Committee
Minutes of 12/07/2011**

The meeting was called to order at 6:02pm by Michael Chammings. Other members present were Hal Ferguson, Dan Peaco, Dave Watson and Peter Laverdiere. Public present were; Scott Bernard, Paul Edes, Linda & Robert Pasco.

Due to the recording secretary's lack of memory the minutes from the 10/26/2011 meeting were not available for approval.

Michael updated us as to actions since 10/26th. Oxford owns the strip of land on the west side of the Dam and they need that access to be able to serve the Dam properly, ie; put in a road (which was just completed parallel to the Mill and water according to permit 25 feet from the water's edge). This will allow Oxford to install electric service to the Dam. (Conduit was laid along side of new road) to make use of the electric gates already in the Dam.

A question was raised on the damaged pillar. Michael has asked engineers as to the need to remove this pillar or could it be laid on the bottom parallel to the dam helping to protect the Dam? Answer is lay it on the bottom.

Water levels remain high due to recent huge rainfall. Motion made by Hal and seconded by Dan to have Michael request the Oxford Selectmen board to permit Michael to query the state as to current water level rules. All agreed.
