2016 Deliberative Session – Review

J. Sherman notes the petitioners were not in attendance at the Deliberative session so discussion was limited on the warrant article.

J. Sherman notes that all the votes on the warrant articles were favorable. The Budget Committee did meet after the Deliberative Session to revote so that the warrant articles reflect the full Budget Committee votes.
