The Officer believes that even though her work schedule runs Tuesday through Saturday, two employees received this benefit regardless of their schedules and therefore, so should she. In addition, she is only receiving .77 cents of the \$1.00 raise promised to her on September 24, 2008. She told Ms. Pratt if she does not receive the compensation, she would file a grievance with her Union.

The Board feels the Officer should receive the full \$1.00 raise promised to her in September; Ms. Pratt will speak with Mrs. Kety about this. She will also confer with Mrs. Arrighi on the best way to handle the Holiday Pay, moving forward.

Mr. Bletzer motions to look to Mrs. Arrighi for guidance on the Monday Holiday Pay issue and as a worst case scenario, to offer the MEO a Compensation Day in lieu of Monday Holiday Pay and Mr. Zanotti seconds

The Officer also requested the Board consider issuing her overtime if there are no Park Plymouth employees available to work on Sundays. The majority of the Board feels it is up to Mr. Ruggiero to find the most cost effective solution to that problem and declines to offer an official answer.
