LICENSES

ONE DAY ALL ALCOHOL LIQUOR LICENSE*

On a motion by Selectman Muratore, seconded by Selectman Brewster, the Board voted to approve the following One Day All Alcohol Liquor License, as detailed below. Voted 3-0-0, approved.

*One day liquor licenses shall automatically cover the day before and the day after the event for the purpose of proper delivery, storage and disposal of alcoholic beverages purchased.

REQUEST TO ISSUE 3rd Quarter Estimated Tax Bill

Finance Director Lynne Barrett presented a request to issue estimated 3rd quarter tax bills from the Assessor's Office. Ms. Barrett explained that, due to the unanticipated resignation of a staff member from the Assessor's Office, the assessing of residential and commercial property has fallen behind schedule. Although the Town has worked quickly to fulfill these duties with the assistance of a consultant, she said, the Department of Revenue is recommending that the Town issue 3rd quarter estimates until the work can be completed. Ms. Barrett noted that, once the new tax rate is certified, the difference between the estimated and actual tax assessments will be billed with the 4th quarter mailing.

On a motion by Selectman Muratore, seconded by Selectman Brewster, the Board voted to approve the issuance of estimated 3rd quarter tax bills, as requested by the Finance Director. Voted 3-0-0, approved.
