CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Quintal called the meeting to order at 7:30 a.m. in Room 303 of Plymouth North High School.

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS OF DISCUSSION

Chairman Quintal discussed a complaint that he received regarding the Building Department and a request for an awning. Chairman Quintal also spoke about a request for a dumpster to be placed on Town Wharf. Ms. Arrighi explained that Patrick O'Brien, Special Assistant to the Town Manager, was working on this issue with those who made the request.

Chairman Quintal expressed concern that the Town's ShowMobile might not be available to those who produce seasonal public events, and he asked that staff try to find additional funds to prevent cancellation of any of these events due to the expense charged (for Public Works expense) to the event organizer. He wondered if the necessary DPW tasks could be done on a volunteer basis or on compensatory time (rather than overtime). Town Management explained that compensatory time is limited based on the collective bargaining agreement; the Town would not want to set the practice of a particular type of work being done on a compensatory time basis. Under the Fair Labor Standards Act, management explained, it is always the employer's decision whether or not to grant compensatory time rather than pay overtime.

ADJOURNMENT OF MEETING

On a motion by Selectman Machado, seconded by Vice Chairman Malaguti, the Board voted to adjourn its meeting at 7:55 a.m. Voted 5-0-0, approved.
