CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Hallisey called the meeting to order at 7:35 a.m.

LICENSES

CHANGE OF MANAGER (LIQUOR LICENSE)

On a motion by Selectman Harnais, seconded by Selectman Brewster, the Board approved a Change of Manager for the following liquor license holder, as detailed below. Voted 4-0-0, approved.

- ❖ **Rye Tavern Corp. d/b/a Rye Tavern** (517 Old Sandwich Road) requested a Change of Manager from Christopher Tocchio to Joanna Farrar. Background check shows no basis for denial.

AUTO DEALER (NEW OWNER)

Liquor liability will be in place before the licenses are released.

*One day liquor licenses shall automatically cover the day before and the day after the event for the purpose of proper delivery, storage and disposal of alcoholic beverages purchased.

ADMINISTRATIVE NOTES

Meeting Minutes – On a motion by Selectman Harnais, seconded by Selectman Muratore, the Board voted to approve the minutes of the December 20, 2011 Selectmen’s meeting.

Voted 4-0-1, approved, with an abstention from Chairman Hallisey, who was unable to attend the December 20th meeting.

Election Warrant and Ballot Summary – The Board unanimously approved and signed the May 12, 2012 local election warrant and ballot summary.

TOWN MEETING ARTICLES

Mr. Stankiewicz updated the Selectmen on the Finance Committee meeting, stating that the members chose not to vote on the Selectmen's budget amendments as it was too late in the process. They voted not to entertain any changes except the increase in personnel services in the Inspectional Services Department.

The Selectmen expressed surprise over the Finance Committee's position and felt that the amendments deserved a conversation.

SOLID WASTE – DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

The Selectmen briefly discussed the solid waste budget and their hopes that the full budget would pass Town Meeting approval. Mr. Stankiewicz confirmed that if the vote does not pass, and the bids for curbside service are favorable, he would anticipate a Special Town Meeting in the summer. Selectman Harnais added that he may make an amendment that would allow funds to include the Hard-to-Manage facility and any tipping fees.

ADJOURNMENT OF MEETING

On a motion by Selectman Muratore, seconded by Selectman Harnais, the Board voted to recess its meeting until Monday evening (April 9, 2012) at 7:00 p.m. Voted 5-0-0, approved.
