Poland Place Major Subdivision Amendment – Map 15, Lot 35

- Jerry Bowes, of Bowes Development LLC is the applicant bringing the major subdivision amendment before the board.
- Chairman George Greenwood discloses that he has done business with the applicant Jerry
 Bowes. Neither Jerry, nor the board finds this to be a problem and it is not necessary for him to
 recuse himself from the discussion.
- Jerry informs the board that all fourteen homes have been completed and sold. The original plan showed a gazebo in the common area. A number of the residents have expressed that they would rather a generator for the pump house to go in, instead of the gazebo. All of the water for the fourteen homes is distributed by this pump house. When the power goes out the residents are unable to use the water since the pump is dependent on CMP power. Most of the residents have backup generators already installed; however that does not service the pump house. Bowes Development is proposing to amend the original plan, replacing the gazebo with a 14 kilowatt generator in a different location. All of the fourteen residents have signed a document stating that they would rather see a generator installed.

- Resident John Simonson believes the signatures of nine months or more are outdated.
 He also believes the gazebo would cost much more than the generator, so he would like to see the money saved by adding the generator added to the association fund.
 - Applicant Jerry Bowes points out that the original site plan did not show any specification for the gazebo, only a location. He believes that Bowes Development has the means to build a gazebo for much less than it would cost for him to purchase a generator.
 - Resident Carol Stillman makes the point that the costs of having to stay
 in a hotel each time the power goes out would greatly outweigh the
 cost of the gazebo over time.
- Resident John Simonson wonders why the gazebo was on the original site plan, but when he went to the county deed registry their plans do not show the gazebo.
 - Applicant Jerry Bowes informs him that the drawings Mr. Simonson is speaking of are actually as built drawings showing what is currently on the parcel, not what is going to be on the parcel. Simply put, the gazebo is not on those drawings because it does not exist on the parcel.
- Vice Chairman William Foster is curious who will be responsible for maintenance of the generator if it is installed.
 - The association will be taking over the responsibility of maintaining the unit.
 Flanders Electric, which will be installing the generator, will service it for two years.
- Also being proposed is a parking space for trailers and RV's. This would be in a small space near the road, and is something that has just recently been added to the plan.
 - Member James Porter asks CEO Nick Adams if a parking area would need to meet setbacks, and it would. The parking area as shown on the plans would not meet the required setbacks.
 - Jerry Bowes informs the board that a majority of the Poland Place development is not in favor of this addition to the site plan and he would like to withdraw it from the application.
 - Chairman George Greenwood asks the public if anyone would be in favor of the parking area and no one comes forward. It is removed from the application.
 - Resident John Simonson questions how Bowes Development LLC has the right to apply for this major subdivision amendment since they are no longer an owner of Poland Place.
 - Jerry Bowes informs him that since the gazebo has not been built the project is not complete and Bowes Development LLC has not been released. Also, on the application Bowes Development is listed as the applicant, and all fourteen owners are listed as the land owners.
 - CEO Nick Adams confirms that Bowes Development LLC has the right to bring the amendment before the board.
