# **NEW BUSINESS**

William Phipps, Formal Shoreland Zoning Application - Map 26 Lot 21

- Contractor Michael Archer is submitting the application for William Phipps.
- Michael Archer submitted an application for a permit to replace a wall on the camp. CEO discovered a
  deck on the property that was not permitted, which puts the lot over its 15% allowance for impervious
  surfaces.
- Mr. Archer moved a walkway on the property which brought the impervious surface percentage right to 15%. Looking to get approval from Planning Board that everything is in compliance so that he may move forward with getting the deck permitted and the camp repaired.
- Chairman Porter clarifies that the reason Michael Archer is submitting this application is to obtain approval for work that has already been done.
- Code Enforcement Officer Nick Adams clarified that Mr. Archer came into the office in April to get a permit to replace the wall facing the lake. Upon reviewing the permit, he realized there was a 10'x18' deck that was installed in 2002 without a permit. Because the deck is within 100' of the water, the CEO cannot issue a permit for the deck without going in front of the Planning Board. Therefore Mr. Archer is here to get approval for the deck and for bringing the property's impervious surface ratio back into compliance.
- Member William Foster asks if the repairs that still need to be done would increase the impervious surfaces. Mr. Archer confirmed that it would not increase, and that repairs to the wall had already been performed due to safety concern.
- Board agrees that phosphorus checklist should be waived because the applicant is correcting existing issues.
- Member William Foster makes a motion to accept the checklist as complete, seconded by George Greenwood with no discussion.
