The Board reviewed plans for a new storefront, doors and windows for a commercial building.

Present on behalf of the application was Jeffrey White, the applicant.

The applicant bought the storefront in disrepair. The two stores are moving out and the applicant proposed to replace the façade and unify the storefront. The applicant proposed to put in new windows and three (3) doors, one (1) for the stairway upstairs and two (2) for the two (2) stores. The applicant proposed an aluminum storefront and the trim on the window will be white. The applicant is gutting the whole building and the two retail tenants are moving out.

A motion to approve was made by Mr. Hoge, seconded by Ms. Concra, and unanimously approved.

260/262 Boston Post Road

The Board reviewed plans for thirteen (13) signs for a commercial building.

Present on behalf of the application was Michael Santoliquido, representing the applicant.

The applicant proposed 14" lettering with white lettering and burgundy trimcap. The sign "262" has reversed halo letters. All the other letters are face lit. The façade has been completely redone. The railings are all to be painted the same color as the building. The applicant stated
