The applicant stated that there will be opaque frosted graphics. This vinyl frost will illuminate light through the windows in both directions. The Board stated that this is an upscale building and there is too much signage.

The Board reviewed plans for one sign for "Canaan Fish Market."

Present on behalf of the application was Byung Ok Kang, the applicant.

The applicant stated that they will replace the sign in the light box and it fits the footage.

# **450 Ellendale Avenue**

The Board reviewed plans for removing existing cedar shakes down to plywood sheathing, installing 3/4" foam insulation, new double 4" vinyl siding in a Savannah Wicker color.

Present on behalf of the application was Carlo LaBianca, for the applicant.

The applicant stated that they would use cedar shingles and the bottom of the house will remain brick. They will use Savannah Wicker siding with no trim change. The gutters and windows will remain the same. The house will blend in with the houses to the left and the right.

A motion to approve was made by Mr. Stover, seconded by Ms. Concra, and unanimously approved.
