#### MEETING HELD APRIL 30, 2012

A meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Port Chester, New York, was held on Monday, April 30, 2012 at 6:00 P.M., in the Court Room of the Police Headquarters Building, 350 North Main Street, Port Chester, New York, with Mayor Dennis Pilla presiding.

Present in addition to Mayor Pilla, were Trustees Daniel Brakewood, Saverio Terenzi, Bart Didden, Luis Marino and Joseph Kenner.

It should be noted that Trustee John Branca was absent.

Also present were Village Manager, Christopher Russo; Village Clerk, Joan Mancuso; Village Attorney, Anthony Cerreto; Village Treasurer, Leonie Douglas; Assistant Village Manager, Christopher Steers and Police Chief Joseph Krzeminski.

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#### **Public Comments:**

Goldie Solomon said to the Board what is this budget going to cost the public stating that our taxes are too high, our assessments are all wrong that the Town does not take into consideration, age, condition and location of our housing stock. She said what about the twelve group homes that are off the tax rolls and noted that our schools are over loaded and that there are people whose children go to our schools but do not pay property taxes.

William Giangrande asked if the Board came down to a zero tax rate because we want a zero tax rate or this Board will not get voted back in.

Lisa Simon a member of the Port Chester-Rye Brook Library Board of Trustees said that the proposed budget has no increase for the Library and told the Board what the impact of a zero percent increase will mean to the Library and our programs. She said that the Library has not received increases from Port Chester or Rye Brook over the last several years and explained the increases the Library has had to absorb including health and retirement costs. Ms. Simon said that the Library is only asking for what they need if we do not get an increase from Port Chester we will have to make big cuts to our hours of operation, services and programs. She noted that our Library has been doing much more with less and it has come to a point that they cannot continue without reduction of services.

Mayor Pilla spoke about the improvements that the Library has made to their facility at no costs to the taxpayers and the wonderful services and programs that they provide. He said that the Library asked for a 5% increase which was reviewed by staff and with our budget restrictions our budget for the Library remained flat but Rye Brook has reviewed the increase for the Library for their budget and proposed a 2.7% increase to their budget for the Library.

Trustee Terenzi asked what is the total Library budget.

Ms. Simon said it is 1.5 million and that the proposed increase for each Village is \$23 thousand.

Trustee Terenzi asked if the \$23 thousand will drastically reduce the Library's 1.5 million budget.

Robin Letierri, Director of the Port Chester-Rye Brook Public Library spoke about the effects if the \$23 thousand increase does not happen. She said that in these hard economic times the Library is being used more and more by the public.

The Mayor noted that we have a unique arrangement regarding the Library funding with an inter-agency agreement with the Village of Rye Brook and the Library and spoke more about this agreement.

Ms. Letierri spoke more about the cost increase to the Library budget including health and retirement costs.

Trustee Terenzi spoke more on the idea about the way we fund the Library and what about the idea of a District.

Ms. Letierri informed the Board that part of the agreement is that in the fifth year that a district would be studied again and that we are going into that review of a district.

Trustee Brakewood praised the Library on everything they have accomplished with the renovations of the building through the Lefferts funding but spoke about the cuts that the Board will be considering tonight that our departments will be facing including the reduction of positions.

Ms. Simon and Ms. Letierri said that the Library itself has been contributing towards its operating budget and spoke about the programs that the Library offers.

Trustee Kenner said that he would like to see where the other proposed amendments go and that he is open to seeing about doing something for the Library but not the entire amount.

Trustee Didden also spoke about the requested increase for the Library and the reduction to Village departments.

Trustee Terenzi spoke about the proposed amendments to the budget that the Board will consider and would recommend approval of what is present and that the Library can come back in a month or so to revisit their request for additional funding.

There was further discussion between the Board on the topic of the Library and Trustee Terenzi inquired about the Ambulance Corps contract.

Mayor Pilla said that we are in the third year of a five year contract with the Ambulance Corps and the Village of Rye Brook and it is a similar way that we asked the Ambulance Corps., regarding alternate ways to operate and its' funding. He said that he thinks that there are opportunities there.

Trustee Terenzi spoke about the finances of the Ambulance Corps stating that they have a large reserve.

The Mayor spoke about larger municipalities and their costs versus ours for this service.

Ms. Letierri asked if the Board has any questions that they please contact her and she will provide them with any additional information.

Richard Abel noted that in the proposed amendments to the budget that \$135,000 is going to be written out of the election budget. He asked if there is an agreement with the Department of Justice on this and if the Board does this reduction will this still blow a big hole in this budget. Mayor Pilla commented on the reasoning of the reduction of the election budget because of one-time costs. He noted that he and staff has spoken to the Department of Justice regarding amendments to the Consent Decree on certain aspects of the voter education program.

Mr. Abel commented that the Board may be putting in jeopardy the agreement with Rye Brook about the Library because we have not funded the increase this year and next year Rye Brook may not contribute more.

John Giangrande said that senior citizens cannot continue to pay these taxes. He said that he would like to stay here but with the taxes the way they are it is pushing people out of the Village.

Ms. Solomon stated that we have a lot of non-profits corporations in the Village that the elite's communities support because they do not want those types of organizations in their communities so we have the impact of them being here.

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#### **Resolutions: Tentative Budget Amendments:**

The Clerk read the first twenty-one resolutions proposing to decrease expenditures to the Tentative Budget for Fiscal Year 2012-2013.

Trustee Brakewood made a motion for discussion on all of these amendments, Trustee Marino seconded the motion.

Mayor Pilla said that with these budget amendments it will decrease the proposed budget to minus .55% from the levy of last year.

Trustee Terenzi spoke about the drop of the levy and noted that the entire Board worked in collaboration over the last few weeks and with these proposed amendments we will still be at 7% because of the drop of the assessables.

Mayor Pilla spoke about the tax rate and said that he is looking at this budget over a two year horizon and wants to advance a business improvement district and a garbage program. He spoke further on the proposed decreases of expenditure.

Trustee Didden said that he would like to discuss resolution #4 that will remove the budget for an assistant for the Village Manager and spoke about the need for someone to assist the Manager and that this position could be filled by an intern which would lower the salary with benefits. He said that he would like the Board to vote this amendment down and in turn resolution #25 that would increase the overtime for the Police Department not be voted for because he explained even if the overtime line is overspent we do not deny the overage it still gets paid without any recourse so would rather fund the position in the Manager's office then authorize more of a budget for overtime for the Police Department. The Board discussed this further.

Trustee Didden made a motion to amend the group of resolutions decreasing the expenditures with the excluding of resolution #4 which would decrease the Village Manager's budget regarding the Assistant to the Village Manager position, vacation buyout and reduction of the education and training line, Mayor Pilla seconded the motion.
