Louise was still looking for the figures of money left in the accounts from last year.

Several renters are behind in their rents. David has been cancelled by the insurance company and he says \$450.00 a year is too high for one policy. He is going to try to hook the coverage into his home owner policy instead.

There is an old sign at Thomas Prince School that should be in/on this building. It will be looked into.

Carl has agreed to be the person who will check on the building when there are problems with the heat. He has done this in the past. The next meeting will be on October 16th at 10:00 am. Gaile will not be here but will get the agenda out before she leaves.
