Eagle Scout Project:

The group discussed Teddy Lingberg's proposed Eagle Scout project to document, catalog and store the monument fragments at Meeting House Cemetery. The group agreed that this is an important and welcomed project and is eager to work with Teddy and his team. Teddy was invited to our next meeting to work out details.

Town Common Guidelines:

Joyce and Sheila got a message from The Town Administrator offering to put our guidelines on an upcoming Select Board meeting agenda. Nina suggested that we delete reference to the Common as 19th century and delete all reference to Dingman Park as part of the Common.

The group discussed the fact that our earlier efforts expressed a stronger stance on protection of the Common and agreed that we need to discuss this further to reach consensus. The topic was tabled pending further review and inclusion of a larger group of members.

Matt agreed to circulate older versions with proposed amendments and Joyce agreed to communicate with Nina.
