A discussion was held relative to the Town Pound located on Mountain Road. Brian Keevan of the Conservation Commission has expressed an interest in cleaning up the pound property and removing some hazard trees, maybe clear out some brush and make the site more visible from the street. Brian was unable to attend tonight's meeting but it was agreed that Joe would follow up and see if we can reschedule another sit down with Brian to discuss his ideas and thoughts.
