Princeton Historical Commission Minutes of meeting May 18, 2017

Meeting called to order 7: 00 p.m.

Minutes for 4-27-17 approved.

Ruth Farnsworth presented us with a proposal for her son's eagle scout project. The proposal was to clean up the vegetation at the Town Pound. We referred her to the Cemetery commission as this land is under their control.

Discussion was had relative to the ongoing work at Meetinghouse Cemetery. Larry met with Bruce Rollins, the cemetery superintendent, who suggested that we relocate the two vaults to a location behind the stone wall in the southwest corner of the property and that they would not need to be buried as they would be out of sight. This location would be more accessible for the future. A motion was made and all approved of using this new location for the vaults and to install locks on them for protection.

Larry Todd met with Tamara regarding ongoing repairs to cemetery stones at Meetinghouse cemetery. Discussion was had as to which stones need the most urgent repairs

And delamination of several stones was considered a priority as well as a broken stone near the entrance gate. It was voted on and approved to allocate our budget money for this project and to allow Larry to negotiate a price for the work to be done using our normal account and the Meetinghouse cemetery account up to a maximum amount of \$1600.00.

The Audubon is planning a celebration of their nomination to the National Historic Register and the dedication of their new historical plaque on Saturday May 20th. Larry plans on attending and agreed to represent the Commission at this event.

A discussion was had concerning the monthly agenda and minutes of our meetings. Joe agreed to send copies of all past minutes to Larry so that he may forward them to Lynn for posting.

Some discussion was had about the updating of our web site and it was agreed to put this on next month's agenda.

Next meeting scheduled for June 22, 2017 @ 7 p.m. at the annex. Meeting was adjourned at 8: 40 p.m.
