1. B. Powers, resident of Calamint Hill North, discussed her concerns about the proposed reconstruction of Calamint Hill North (paving and drainage).

- A. Road project is too costly
- B. Questions whether a majority of the residents of the road want the project to move forward
- C. Wants to keep the road unpaved, it has scenic value
- D. Road has historic value as is
- E. Lacks benefit to most residents of the town
- F. Feels project is a done deal without input from the residents of the road

2. Regarding Calamint Hill North

- A. The Selectboard has given the okay for the road to be constructed.
- B. The road has no engineering plan as of yet. Glen has been on the road with an engineer to discuss water management (drain issues).
- C. Highway department has constant maintenance of the road, cost of time, manpower and equipment.
- D. Question of the road's safety (icing and washouts) in the winter and spring on its unpaved surface.
- E. At this time, there is no definite timeline for the work to begin.
- F. Residents will be notified with certified letters when engineering plans are finalized and meetings will be held for residents' concerns and input.

3. Board reviews road plan (draft) on East Princeton bridge project.

- A. Awaiting a contract signing between town and engineering firm.

4. Board reviews draft of financial spreadsheet for future road plans that includes estimated road costs and money from town and state chapter 90 funds.
