#14 Dave Knowlton spoke to the issue and how we need to improve storm water quality as per state regulations. On a recent visit by the state there were illicit discharges discovered by an audit of the tests that Salem sand Coast watch. This 200,000 will <sup>be used to</sup> cover a consent order to remove the connections from 5 areas in the City that were discovered. It covers 4 1/2 miles of pipe, 150 man holes and 170 catch Basins. Juniper beach, Derby St wharf area, Pioneer Village Commercial and Mason and Dunlap Streets into North River.

Councillor Ryan asked who pays to fix the problem pipes coming from residents and is it typical of older homes.

Mr. Littlehale stated that it made more sense to handle the money coming into the Automotive repair shop should be handled like the culinary arts program (Black Cat Cafe)


