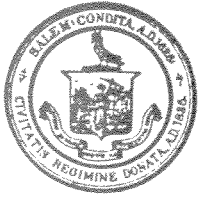

Amended Order In City Council, _____

Ordered: Not 2nd Matter Fails

Due to various safety concerns concerning trailering boats on Canal Street in the area of Mt Donalds, in Riley Plaza, or at the intersection of Loving and Canal Streets, ~~the City Council~~ ^{recognizing} and the need to transport boats to the harbor, the Council orders that ^{per § 20A of the city of Salem Traffic Code} for a 60 day experimental ~~period~~ period, full Boat Trailers, shall be allowed use Forest Avenue from May 1, 2011 through July 1, 2011 between the hours of 8:00am and 3:00pm. All other commercial truck traffic shall remain forbidden from traversing Forest Avenue during this experimental 60 day period.
