**MEETING MINUTES**

A meeting of the Salem Licensing Board was held on Monday, June 8, 2015 at 6:45 p.m., at City Hall Annex, 120 Washington Street in the third floor conference room. In attendance: were members Rick Lee and Paul Flores, Special Investigator Det. Sgt. Dennis Gaudet and Clerk of the Board, Melissa Pagliaro. Absent was Chairman Bob St. Pierre.

1. Application for new/renewals of Street Performers Licenses. Applicants: Danny Norwood, Anna Seminara, Kaylin Molina, Trevor Limatanien, Bruce Lawson and Michael Coty.

Applicants were introduced to the Board and informed of the rules and regulations. Paul Flores motioned to approve 5 of the applications except for Trevor Limatanien who was not present. Rick Lee seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion approved.

2. Applications for several One Day Liquor Licenses. Applicant: Robin Perry, representing Hamilton Hall.

3. Application from Donna Martin, Mill River Winery to be a vendor for the 2015 Farmer's Market.

Donna Martin, co-owner from Mill River Winery presented her application to be a vendor at the 2015 Farmers Market from June through October. She said this is her 4<sup>th</sup> year and that all of her staff are TIPS certified.

Sgt. Gaudet just reminded her to make sure they are checking ID's before giving samples out. Paul Flores motioned to approve. Rick Lee seconded. All in favor. Motion approved.

4. Application from K & S Golf Management d/b/a Tee Time Grill, 75 Wilson Street, Municipal Golf Course for a Seasonal All Alcohol Liquor License.

Keith Hagman and Scott MacDonald were present. Mr. Hagman said they are the new vendors for the Municipal Golf Course and are applying for what was there before which is a Seasonal All Alcohol License. Paul Flores motioned to approve. Rick Lee seconded. All in favor. Motion approved.

5. Application from Koto Grill, Washington Street, for a Change of Officers and Directors and Transfer of Stock of their Liquor License.

Eric Easley presented his application for a Lodging House License at 89 Congress Street. He said that this address has been a rooming house for a very long time and that he has run another one at 73 Harbor Street for the last 16 years. Rick lee said that this was Orville L' Heurreux's place for a very long time and he ran it very well. Paul Flores motioned to approve. Rick Lee seconded. All in favor. Motion approved.

8. Application from Crowther Brewn, LLC d/b/a Derby Joe, 142 Derby Street for a Common Victuallers License and an Entertainment License.

Daniel Crowther and Daniel Cordon presented the application for a Common Victuallers License and Entertainment License.

Dan said that this is a new coffee shop they are opening. He said it will be open 7 days a week from 6 am to 8 pm and will accommodate about 14 people. Paul Flores motioned to approve. Rick Lee seconded. All in favor. Motion carries.
