

Board of Commissioners of Trust Funds
Minutes of the June 11, 2015 Meeting

Present: Mayor Driscoll, William P. Goreham, Thaddeus Buczko, and Sumner Jones

Mayor Driscoll called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM.

Mayor Driscoll made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 14, 2015 meeting. The motion was seconded by Sumner Jones and voted unanimously.

The Council on Aging submitted a request for medication reimbursement for Salem residents. Sumner Jones made a motion to approve \$130.92 from the Endicott Fund for these requests. The motion was seconded by William P. Goreham and voted unanimously.

The Council on Aging submitted a request on behalf of a medically disabled resident for an air conditioner. Sumner Jones made a motion to approve \$649.95 from the Endicott Fund for this request. The motion was seconded by William P. Goreham and voted unanimously.

A statement was received from Deschamps Printing for the Read Picnic tickets. William P. Goreham made a motion to approve \$358.00 from the Read Picnic Fund for the request. The motion was seconded by Sumner Jones and voted unanimously.

The Cemetery Commission submitted a statement from the Boston Computer Scanning Company for scanning work completed. Sumner Jones made a motion to approve \$815.04 from the Perpetual Care Fund for this request. The motion was seconded by William P. Goreham and voted unanimously.

Five organizations presented their proposals for Fiscal Year 2016:

Boys & Girls Club - \$13,600 – Elevated Thought Program
Salem YMCA - \$10,000 – Staff Costs for Teen Program
Children’s Friend Society – \$10,000 – Mentor Program, \$5,000 Teen Parent Program
Plummer Home - \$10,000 – Teen Programs
St. Vincent de Paul Society - \$2,000 – General Assistance and Food Programs
