Petition of MICHAEL BEAULIEU, requesting a special permit per Sec. 3.3.2 *Nonconforming Uses* and Section 9.4 *Special Permits* of the Salem Zoning Ordinance, to allow the extension of the existing nonconforming retail use, in order to sell firearms at the property located at 128 MARGIN STREET (R2 Zoning District).
