Extension of Variances

On Wednesday, May 19, 2010, the Zoning Board of Appeals of the City of Salem voted in favor to approve the application of High Rock Bridge Street, LLC, for Variances to allow the construction of a 2-4 story professional office building with retail and municipal space in the North River Canal Corridor Neighborhood Zoning District. A Decision dated June 2, 2010 was filed with the City of Salem Clerk's Office on June 2, 2010, and such Decision is recorded with the Essex South District Registry of Deeds in Book 29680, Page 375 (the "Decision").

On May 18, 2011, the Salem Zoning Board of Appeals extended the variances granted on May 19, 2010 for six (6) months to November 19, 2011 by a vote of 5-0 (Bonnie Belair, Annie Harris, Rebecca Curran, Richard Dionne, and Jamie Metsch in favor, none opposed).

The Board understands High Rock Bridge Street, LLC intends to go forward with the project, though additional time is needed to obtain all required State permits.
