## Withdrawal without Prejudice


City of Salem Zoning Board of Appeals

Petition of JOSEPH BUKOWSKI requesting Variances and Special Permits in order to allow the first floor of the building on 19 BRIDGE ST to be used for commercial purposes, and for a Variance from the off-street parking regulations relating to such commercial use (B-2).

On January 18, 2012, the Board of Appeals met to discuss the petitioner's request to withdraw the above referenced petition without prejudice. The following Board of Appeals members were present: Annie Harris (acting as Chair), Richard Dionne, Jamie Metsch, Jimmy Tsitsinos, and Bonnie Belair.

At the request of the Petitioner, the Board of Appeal voted 5-0 (Harris, Dionne, Metsch, Belair and Tsitsinos on favor, none opposed) to allow the Petitioner to withdraw this petition without prejudice.
