Call to Order: Chairman Nicolaisen called the meeting to order at 6:10 P.M.

Ms. Blaisdell explained the purpose of tonight's meeting. She explained that the Board needs to decide how much money they'd like to pay to the school district from the town's impact fee account for 2011. This amount will be sent to the SAU and used to offset the town's portion of capital improvements at the schools which in turn can reduce the school portion of our tax rate.

The Board looked at the spreadsheet provided by the Planning Board which showed that \$123,506.46 will expire in 2011 if not used. There was discussion on how much to use this year with the understanding that in future years there may not be as much money available to put towards the school because it's hard to predict how much building there will be in the future.

The Board's final decision was to expend \$170,000 from the account.

MOTION: Selectman Brown moved to expend \$170,000 from the School Impact Fee account and make this contribution to the school. Selectman Tombarello seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Selectman Brown moved to adjourn the meeting at 6:25 P.M. Selectman Devine seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
