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**Mosquito Spraying**

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- Ms. Blaisdell informed the Board that she received a call this afternoon from the State stating that mosquitos collected at the Ed Garvey Recreation Center tested positive for West Nile Virus. The type of mosquitos found are typically only bird biting and rarely bite humans. Dragon Mosquito originally was not alarmed and suggested monitored testing but later changed their opinion since Old Home Days was this coming weekend. Because of all the scheduled events, the consensus of the board is to move forward with preventative spraying of the usual areas, Sandown Central School, Sandown North School, Ed Garvey Recreation Area and Miller Recreation Area. They are hoping to spray on Thursday, weather permitting with Friday as a rain date.

The remainder of the meeting will be considered a non meeting under the Right to Know Law, 91-A. The selectmen will be discussing legal matters with the Town Attorney.

Chairman Tombarello adjourned the meeting at 6:20 P.M.
